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Commissioner's Discussion:

Tennis Courts at Countryside School require maintenance. A proposal for \$60,0000 was presented to the Board. This will be an expense for next year as this year purchasing a new tractor will take precedence.

Margaret Palmer presented the Advisory Committee report to the Board which included:

- Request to install a fence and gate at the Hunt House driveway entrance. A map of where the fence should be installed should be presented at the next board meeting.
- Fencing at the Horizon Farm track area should be considered.
- Request riders trailering their horses to the Riding Center provide a current Coggins test for their horse.

The Pony Club purchased an Equicizer (electric riding horse) and asked to store it in the meeting room storage closet. One suggestion was to store it in the meeting room with a cover and lock. Another suggestion was to use a nearby stall to house this equipment.

The Pony club would like three trees transplanted from the bleacher/outdoor jump arena area because they block the view to the stadium jumping field during the Horse Trials. It may be possible to move the bleachers to another area. This will be further discussed in the Fall.
